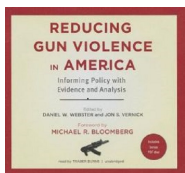

**October 28, 7 p.m.**

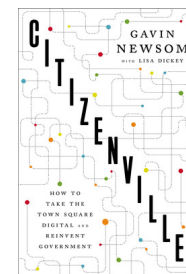
#### ***Citizenville: How to Take the Town Square Digital and Reinvent Government***
